Please take time to read over the following notes to orient you to camp this year:

1. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, there are restrictions in place to prevent the spread of the virus. Because of these restrictions, the Sea to Sky Aphasia Camp cannot be held in person.
2. As a result, Sea to Sky Aphasia Camp will be online for 2020!

5. Note: you may experience “Zoom Fatigue” during the virtual camp. Online meetings require more focus than in-person meetings. If you feel tired, or have difficulty focusing, feel free to take a break!

I understand that Sea to Sky Aphasia Camp and its partners The University of British Columbia, March of Dimes Canada, and Douglas College will not be monitoring, evaluating, or providing medical attention for health care needs.

My well-being and safety is my responsibility throughout the course of the weekend camp experience.

I understand and agree that Sea to Sky Aphasia Camp and its partners, The University of British Columbia, March of Dimes Canada, and Douglas College, are not responsible for any loss, injury, damage or expense suffered by a person arising from or related to participation in Virtual Camp or use of the equipment, for any reason whatsoever, including negligence on the part of all partners involved, its officers, employees, servants, agents, students or volunteers.

Each camp activity carries inherent risks for campers.
