<p><b>1. Activity Champions</b></p> <p>Students will be in teams of 6 over the weekend. Each team will “champion” at least one activity over the weekend. Examples of responsibilities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensuring communication resources are available at each activity</li><li>• Overseeing the activity</li><li>• Reporting any successes/challenges to the Camp Committee</li></ul> <p>An activity schedule will be shared with you prior to the orientation evening on August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022. During orientation, you will have the opportunity to discuss your activity with your team.</p>
<p><b>2. Resource Fair</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Aphasia Camp Resource Fair is led by Douglas College’s Therapeutic Recreation students.</li><li>• This year, each healthcare student cohort is encouraged to share discipline-specific information to campers around community health and wellness tips and opportunities to promote access to services beyond aphasia camp.</li><li>• Examples of information you could share include communicatively and/or physically accessible groups and resources in your communities e.g. aphasia groups, exercise classes, educational resources and workshops etc.</li></ul>

#### Before Camp

##### Training:

- A series of three emails will be sent to all participating students to the email addresses provided (for UBC students: Please check your email regularly throughout July and August).
- These emails will be from the week of the July 11<sup>th</sup> onwards. The emails will consist of links to video content, and reading material to facilitate your orientation to the camp, as well as working with people with aphasia.
- An orientation night will be held on Thursday, the 11<sup>th</sup> of August 2022 from 4:00 – 9:00 PM at the School of Audiology and Speech Sciences at UBC. This will tie together the content delivered in the previous weeks, as well as provide interprofessional learning content, and greater details for a successful camp.

#### During Camp

- **Meals** are set throughout the day – dinner on Friday night, lunch and dinner on Saturday, and lunch on Sunday. Please let us know if you have any dietary needs/restrictions, but note that these are an extra cost for the camp so please select accordingly. Campers, students and Clinical Faculty all eat meals together. Please feel free to bring snacks/nibbles that you can snack on throughout the day. Campers, students and Clinical Faculty are responsible for their own breakfasts.
- **Activities** will be scheduled from Friday evening through to Sunday afternoon. You will be grouped in teams – typically five students, and five campers. The goal of the camp is to ensure campers have access to activities, while also providing the opportunity for social interaction between campers. You will be developing the skills to ensure these successful interactions occur. You will also have the opportunity to develop rapport with students from other health professions, and learn from each other through leading activities over the weekend, both as discipline-specific groups, as well as within your interdisciplinary teams.
- **Continued support** will be provided throughout the weekend. You will have the opportunity to meet with your team leader/clinical faculty member, both as a team and individually. You may also request meetings as needed.

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#### **Post Camp**

- Once all campers have left, a debrief will be held immediately at UBC. This will take no longer than one hour.
- In addition to the debrief, you will have the opportunity to provide feedback and evaluate your experiences at camp.
- Any student requiring signature for IPE/clinical hours can have their forms signed at this point.
